### **Reported Incident Type: Rape**

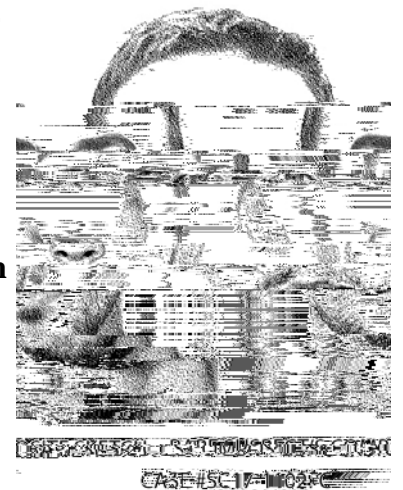

**Location:** Fresno City College, Parking Lot "D" (near McKinley Avenue)

**Suspect:** Unknown, Hispanic, Male, 20's, Approx. 6'01", 180 lbs., Short Dark Brown Hair, Brown Eyes, Unshaven, Black T-Shirt, Dark Jeans, White Tennis Shoes

**Suspect Vehicle:** Unknown Year, Silver, 4 Door, Nissan, Altima



In late September on a Wednesday evening, a Fresno City College female student was walking back to her parked car, which was located in Lot "D" near McKinley Avenue. She was dragged into the back seat of a silver sedan, by a light-complected Hispanic adult, where she was then sexually assaulted. SCCC-PD is currently investigating this crime and is attempting to locate witnesses. **Anyone with information regarding this incident is urged to contact the SCCC-PD at (559) 244-6140.**
