On March 13, 2024, at approximately 10:11 am, a Madera Community College Instructor reported a female driving a Dark Gray 2014 Jeep Wrangler, who at empted to run over members of his class and him; she then f ed the campus. No one was hit, and no injuries were sustained during the alleged assault.

At approximately 10:36 am, Madera County Deput es, along with the CHP, intercepted the suspect's vehicle. It was reported that the suspect displayed non-cooperat ve and errat c behavior and physically assaulted the Of cers before she was successfully detained and apprehended.

Given the likelihood of her eligibility for bail and potent al release from custody, coupled with her errat c behavior, the SCCCD PD believes Ms. Gonzalez poses a serious and ongoing threat to the MCC Campus Community.

If you encounter Ms. Gonzalez on the MCC campus, we strongly urge you <u>not</u> to confront her. Instead, please call SCCCD PD immediately at (559) 244-6140, or dial 9-1-1 to report her presence and let law enforcement handle the situat on. Your safety and that of the college community are of paramount importance.
