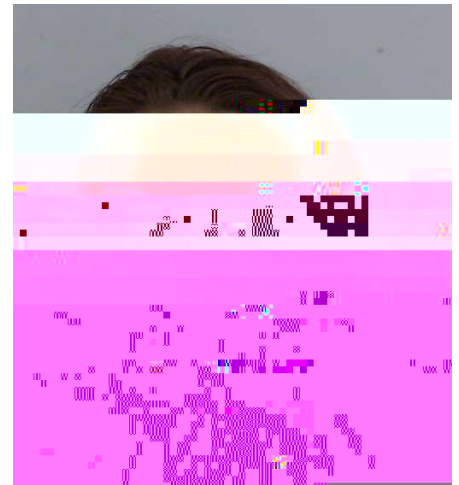


Timely Warning

On March 13, 2024, at approximately 10:11 am, a Madera Community College Instructor reported a female driving a Dark Gray 2014 Jeep Wrangler, who attempted to run over members of his class and him; she then fled the campus. No one was hit, and no injuries were sustained during the alleged assault.

At approximately 10:36 am, Madera County Deputies, along with the CHP, intercepted the suspect's vehicle. It was reported that the suspect displayed non-cooperative and erratic behavior and physically assaulted the Officers before she was successfully detained and apprehended.

Given the likelihood of her eligibility for bail and potential release from custody, coupled with her erratic behavior, the SCCC PD believes Ms. Gonzalez poses a serious and ongoing threat to the MCC Campus Community.

If you encounter Ms. Gonzalez on the MCC campus, we strongly urge you not to confront her. Instead, please call SCCC PD immediately at (559) 244-6140, or dial 9-1-1 to report her presence and let law enforcement handle the situation. Your safety and that of the college community are of paramount importance.
