- (b) When an officer is faced with a situation that may require the delivery of accurate and effective fire at long range.
- (c) Situations where an officer reasonably expects the need to meet or exceed a suspect's firepower.
- (d) When an officer reasonably believes that there may be a need to deliver fire on a barricaded suspect or a suspect with a hostage.
- (e) When an officer reasonably believes that a suspect may be wearing body armor.
- (f) When authorized or requested by a supervisor.
- (g) When needed to euthanize an animal.

Fiscal Impacts:

The semiautomatic rifles and associated equipment/accessories have already been purchased over time. Ongoing maintenance, ammunition, and/or replacement costs will vary.

Legal/Procedural Rules Governing Use:

All applicable local, state, and federal laws governing police use of force as well as all applicable State Center Community College District Police Department policies concerning Use of Force, Firearms, and Patrol Rifles.

Training Required:

Officers are required to successfully complete departmental training. This training shall consist of an initial 24-hour patrol rifle user's course and qualification score with a certified patrol rifle instructor. Officers shall thereafter be required to successfully complete quarterly training and qualification conducted by a certified patrol rifle instructor.
